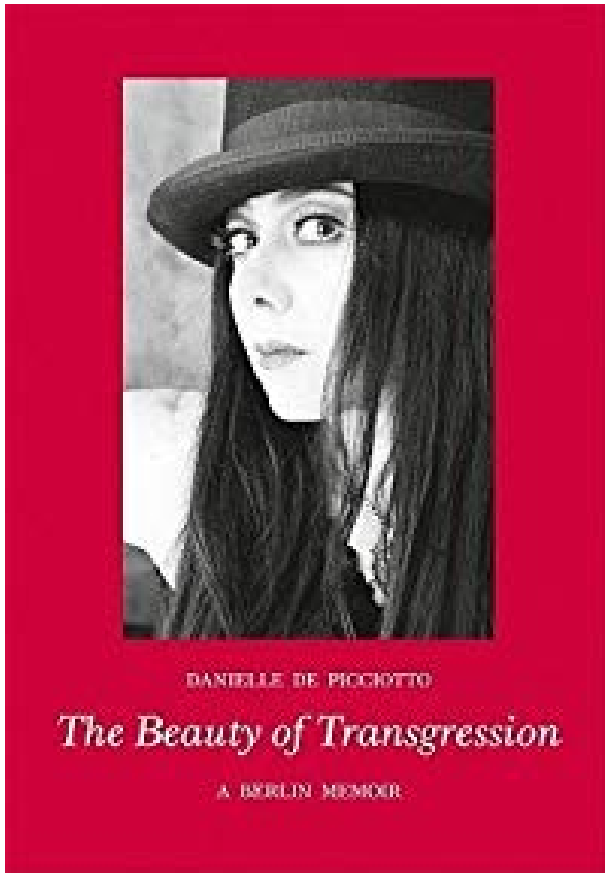


# The Beauty of Transgression: A Berlin Memior
